Saint Fiacre was born in Ireland at the end of the sixth century. He was raised in a monastery where he became a monk and imbibed knowledge of herbal medicine. In time he had his own hermitage and perhaps a monastery, possibly near St. Fiachra's Well at Cill Fiachra (Kilferagh), Sheastown, As crowds flocked to him because of his reputation for his holiness and cures, he sailed to France in search of greater solitude. When he arrived at Meaux in 628, the bishop St Faro, granted him a site.

Fiacre cleared the ground of trees and briers, made a cell for himself, a garden for herbs and vegetables, a chapel and a hospice for travelers. All this developed into the village of Saint-Fiacre. Again in time the crowds flocked to him in search of cures. He died around 670.

He has become the patron saint of gardeners. In 1999 a garden in his honour was made at the National Stud in Kildare. It has become a major tourist attraction. Fiacre is also the patron of taxi-drivers.
