ST CANICE'S ANNUAL MASS OF REMEMBRANCE

St Canice's Parish will hold its **Annual Mass of Remembrance on Wednesday** 27th **November at 7.30 pm in St Canice's Church.** All parishioners and those from other communities who have relatives or friends who hail from the parish are invited to attend. As on previous occasions families who have experienced bereavement during the past year will take pride of place at this celebration of remembrance and prayer for the dead of the parish.

During the celebration of Mass the names of all who died during the past year will be called and each family will be presented with a special candle for the occasion. If you have a family member who died outside the parish during the year please leave in their names before 23rd Nov to the Parish Centre and a candle will be prepared for them and their names remembered during the Liturgy. Refreshments will be served in the Parish Centre after the Mass

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is celebrated communally in our parish during the seasons of Advent and Lent. However, should you wish to celebrate individually we are offering you the opportunity to come to St. Canice's on Saturday evenings at 7.00 when one of the priests will be available. Confessions will be heard in the area in front of the Virgin Mary's statue at the top of the left of the church where a confessional is situated. The penitent has the option to remain anonymous or to meet the priest face to face.
